GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSIONS

- 1) A&G Magazine is an online publication with bi-monthly PDFs distributed without cost to its 10,000+ subscribers. As such, we don't purchase articles. We prefer to see the online publication as a forum for establishing points of view and expertise from voluntary contributors.
- 2) Please fill out the synopsis on page 3 and email or fax it to (512) 478-8873 or editor@architectureandgovernance.com before creating your submission.
- 3) Of course, if you already have an article prepared for submission, please also forward a copy of the article.
- 4) Synopses will be reviewed in a timely manner, and you will be contacted with an "accept or decline."
- 5) All articles submitted should be easy to read and free of grammatical mistakes.
- 6) Your voluntary submission to A&G Magazine will carry the "Reserved Rights" copyright of A&G Magazine, which will require your authorization for additional content repurposing or monthly publications.
- 7) All articles must be accompanied by a brief biography and hi-res image of the author.
- 8) Generally speaking, A&G articles run 800 to 1200 words.
- 9) A&G submissions by vendors and/or vendor representatives must provide submission content that is both product—and vendor—neutral. A&G Magazine reserves the right to edit, modify, or reject submissions that include a distinctly favorable slant to any one vendor.
- 10) Submission of an abstract, synopsis, or a full article contribution is no guarantee of publication.
- 11) A&G reserves the right to edit all submissions for length and suitability to a given issue, without final and formal review of the contributor. However, A&G will make every effort to allow an author to preview such alterations.
